Friday: 12:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m.

Saturday: 6:30 a.m.-7:30 a.m.

Sunday: 6:30 a.m.-8:30 a.m.

The outdoor arena is open for schooling and lunging all day.

SHOW FEES

Class Fee: \$25 per class

Office Fee: \$25 per horse/rider combination

Medic Fee: \$10 per horse/rider combination

Stall Fee: \$40/per day. One bag of shavings included.

Shavings: \$8 per bag - Hay: \$11 per bale

Grounds Fee: \$25 per horse, per competition day,
for those without a stall

Non-Showing Horse Fee: \$145 per horse, per day

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entries may be submitted by:
 - www.horseshowing.com
 - Paper entries available at the horse show office. Faxed or emailed entries will NOT be accepted.
2. Credit cards may be used for payment of entries.
3. Stalls, as available, will be 10' x 10' temporary stalls with doors for a fee of \$40 per day.
4. Schooling is only open to exhibitors entered in the horse show. This will be strictly enforced.
5. Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by management and back numbers must be issued and worn.
6. All riders must wear proper attire and protective ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
7. An EMT is available during horse show hours. He is stationed near the announcer's stand.
8. Unconventional hunter tack or equipment will not be permitted, at the judge's discretion.
9. Proof of Negative Coggins required within one year is required of every horse entering The Jaeckle Centre. Out of state horses must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (within 30 days). Horses originating within the state of Tennessee are required to be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary inspection within 150 days. This paperwork must accompany all horses upon arrival. Do not send with entries.
10. Coats optional and braiding not necessary
11. All classes judged on performance and soundness
12. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, move or substitute classes at their discretion.
13. Class courses will be posted the day of the classes near the in gate.
14. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
15. Every class offered is operated in accordance with the current rules of the MTHJA. To be eligible for year-end awards, the exhibitor, the owner and the horse or pony must be registered with the Association. Applications are available from the Show Secretary.
16. Every effort has been made to avoid errors in this publication. The Jaeckle Centre assumes no liability for errors. Any changes will be disclosed to competitors upon receipt of entries. Any disputes not covered in the rules will be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
